The main functions of the World Health Assembly are to determine the policies of the Organization, appoint the Director-General, supervise financial policies, and review and approve the proposed programme budget. The WHA is held annually in Geneva, Switzerland. The WHA74 **will take place virtually from 24 May to 1 June 2021**, in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
